Awards:

Admission:

- There will be a \$3 entry fee for adults, and a \$2 entry fee for students who are **not** participating in the tournament. Free wrist bands will be given with purchased entry! Fee to play is \$40/team.

Partial Rules & Regulations:

- Entry deadline: Wednesday, May 1st.
- One-day, double elimination tournament format.
- Two Divisions: 1)8th grade and below, may include seniors 65 and up. 2)8th grade to senior (64) and under.
- Team size shall be three players minimum and five players maximum. Your team will be placed in the age/grade category of the oldest player. Players may play up in division, but not down.
- Junior division will be played in the Middle School gym. Older division will play in the HS gym.
- Team check-in: 8:30 a.m. HS Gym (brief rules meeting to follow) **Every player must check-in to compete.**
- Games to begin at 9:30 a.m. Please show up early to your games, we want to stay on schedule.
- Brackets will be revealed by May 8, 2019. Tournament will be seeded by random draw.
- Each team can have a maximum of five players and three players must be present to avoid disqualification. **Upper division- Each team must have at minimum one female on the court.**
- Each player can only play on one team for the length of the tournament.
- Players, must read and sign the entry and liability and waiver form.
- Any participant under the age of 18 must have signature of parent or legal guardian.
- Each team must sign up by the deadline of Wednesday, May 1st.
- Games will be 7:00 minutes in length. The games will be scored by one's and two's. If it's a tie, free throws will determine the winner.
- A coin toss will determine who gets the ball first.
- Substitutions can be made at any dead ball with the approval of the referee/ court monitor.
- All decisions made by referees' /court monitors are FINAL
- Any non-shooting foul will result in ball being checked up at the 3pt line. Shooting fouls will be one shot for one point.
- Any intentional, flagrant or technical foul will result in one point for the offended team and possession of the ball. A penalty of 1:00 time-out will be accessed to the aggressor.
- Referees/court monitors have the ability to bench or eject players for disciplinary reasons (language, disrespect to referees or player, etc.)
